XTF's Country Rotation Portfolios (CRP) may invest in ETFs that track the following 13 countries: The Netherlands, Germany, France, Switzerland, Italy, United Kingdom, Belgium, Australia, Singapore, Hong Kong, Japan, Canada and South Africa. The company has also modeled several other foreign countries for potential future inclusion.

The CRP is designed to take advantage of changes in the risk levels and the appreciation potential of the individual countries it follows. XTF models each country independently, and compares its risk/reward profile to an equivalent investment in intermediate-term U.S. Treasuries. If the country profile is favorable versus 7-10 Year U.S. Treasury Bonds, XTF invests in the country ETF. Alternatively, if the Treasury Bond has a more favorable profile, XTF invests in the Treasury Bond 7-10 Year iShare ETF. Each country in the CRP is equally weighted at approximately 7.7 percent of the overall portfolio.
